

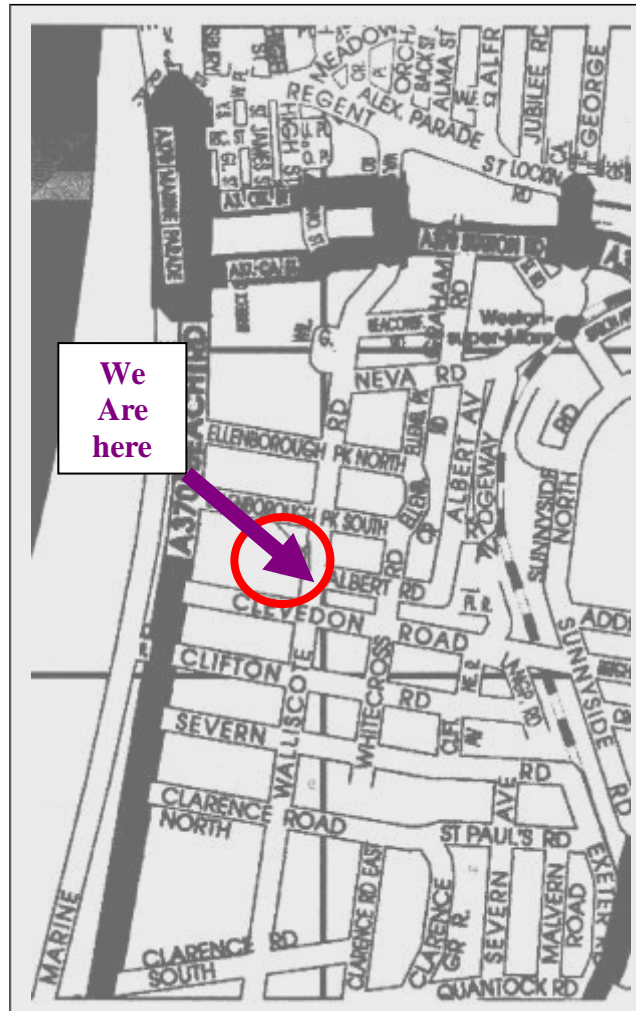
Our Worship
