MISSION NEWS Our Link Missionaries, Alan and Megan Barker, have now returned to their work in Nepal after an enjoyable break in the UK seeing family and friends. It was sad we couldn't see them here at CPBC, but they were quickly booked up by other churches. I should have moved more quickly!!!

Nepal has been hit by climate change in a big way. This time of the year is Monsoon time when the rice crop is planted, and the rains help it to grow. Unfortunately, in the south of the country on the flat lands known as the Terai, there has been a severe drought – no Monsoon rains – and the crop has withered. This will have a knock-on effect of food shortages later in the year. Rice is Nepal's staple crop – everyone eats rice. This is a reminder of how vulnerable the people of Nepal are to climate change, as the country is recognised as one of those most at risk by this change.

This also means that there is a general water shortage in the area and fire engines and other vehicles have been deployed to take water to the affected areas. This is unknown in the middle of the Monsoon period.

Please pray that the Monsoon rains will return and the rice crop planted.

Alan and Megan give thanks for having a good break but for wisdom and strength to return to their work in Nepal. They also thank God that though their luggage arrived 26 hours after them it was delivered directly to their house!!
