## MISSION NEWS

The remote mountainous district of Rukum in Nepal is one of the least developed areas in Nepal. It has unproductive land, people have poor health and hygiene, there is little education for the children, there is caste discrimination, deforestation and poor living standards.

Operation Agri is working with groups in the area to improve living standards, uplift socially oppressed people, and addressing education and health needs thus raising the living standards of the people.

In Khamdai village the Head Teacher of Sharee Janchetana Primary School said that the Multi-Purpose Community Development Service (MCDS) has provided tables, chairs, cupboards, schoolworking equipment and a swing. As a result, children who rarely came before are now coming full time and the village has a school of 21 children who are enjoying the opportunity to learn.

Praise God for the way that Operation Agri is involved in both these projects.
