<u>MISSION NEWS</u> Surrounded by sand dunes and cliffs the remote village of Gouro in northern Chad is practically unreachable by road. To get there from the capital N'Djamena is a journey of three to four days across harsh desert terrain. Dr Luke Ardill's Mission Aviation Flight (MAF) takes less than four hours.

Once there, he can provide diabetes and chronic disease training, support local clinic staff and build relationships in an area with limited healthcare and education. He says that by training staff we can create a trickle-down effect. This community was originally resistant to the Gospel, but the medical ministry is a great way of sharing God's love through the building of relationships and meeting physical needs. Luke also partners with an NGO (non-government organisation) that promotes language literacy in primary schools. If they had to drive to Gouro, the Dr. says it would reduce the time they would have for medical care and education. During one visit they heard about a teenager who had been bitten by a scorpion the night before. She made it to the clinic and received antivenom, but it was too late, and she died. This highlights the need of improved healthcare access in these areas.

As well as medical personnel and equipment, MAF brought electrical supplies to repair a solar powered system in the health clinic that had been without power for two years. If MAF didn't fly, it is difficult to know what would happen to the people in terms of healthcare and education. Maureen Price
