## Mission News - **KATHMANDU INTERNATIONAL STUDY CENTRE (KISC)**

In 1987 KISC was formed by the Christian Organisation, United Mission to Nepal, as a Secondary School for children of Mission Workers and other Ex-Patriot workers in Nepal. **It started with just 7 pupils in February 1987 and gradually expanded because of the excellent teaching the children were receiving. Today there are 220 children in the school who come from 20 countries around the world. BMS World Mission is one of the Mission Boards involved. One of the early teachers at this school was Philippa Munday whose brother is a Deacon at Milton BC and whose mother is a member at Worle BC.**

**Eventually KISC felt it should be doing something for the children of Nepal and so KISC EQUIP was formed where teachers from the school either go out into the villages or bring teachers into the city and give them good training on the best way to teach. This has proved to be very popular with the teachers and the Government Education Department. In 2007 the Nepali Government accepted KISC as an official Christian School within Nepal.**

**Please pray for the children and staff in this school but especially for the work among the Nepali teachers that the training they have through KISC EQUIP will improve the education of the Nepali children and that the Gospel will become known throughout the country because of this work.**
