MISSION NEWS – NEWS FROM BIBLE SOCIETY.

Wilson lives in Guatemala City. When he was 14 years old, he saw his brother gunned down and bleed to death. Wilson wanted revenge and joined a gang. He had been given a Bible when he was 5 years old and together with his brother had always gone to Church, but when his brother was killed Wilson turned his back on God. He was determined to kill the person who shot his brother but often when he left the house to look for the man, he heard a voice telling him to stop. Eventually Wilson was arrested for having a gun and sent to a youth detention centre and that was where he met members of the Bible Society Open Book Team. He loved watching and listening to the stories from the Bible especially those where he learned that God never abandons his children. Wilson has told the Bible Society Team that he doesn't seek revenge anymore and he knows that his life is in God's hands, and it was God's voice he heard before. When asked what hopes he had for the future he said "I want to be somewhere with better opportunities. I would love to train as a doctor so that I could save lives".

Please pray for Wilson and the other prisoners who regularly attend the "Open Book" sessions in that youth detention centre that they may turn around their lives and follow Jesus.
